KPAD

The Kananaskis Improvement District is pleased to announce a new program being unrolled in Kananaskis: the Kananaskis Public Access Defibrillation (KPAD) program will be launching this November, with the first AED (automated external defibrillator) to be installed in the Village Centre. Every year, over 40,000 Canadians will suffer cardiac arrest, and every minute without defibrillation decreases chances of survival by 7-10%. With many of these incidents occurring in public spaces, it is vital to have AED's located where the public have access. Thanks to the generous support of the Kananaskis Improvement District, the public will see 10 AED units located around Kananaskis over the next two years. These units will be accessible by visitors, residents, staff and first responders to help decrease the time from sudden cardiac arrest to defibrillation, increasing chances of survival. Watch for AEDs showing up at some of your favourite recreation sites around Kananaskis!

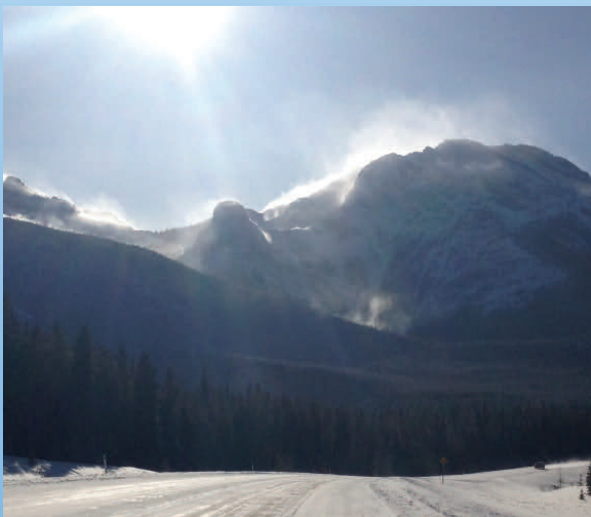

IS YOUR VEHICLE READY FOR THE SNOW?



Living in our semi-remote community we have to drive to get into Town. Fall is the perfect time to be sure your vehicle is ready. Check your anti-freeze, make sure your heater and defroster are working well and that the vent intake is clean of debris such as pine needles, ensure that your wiper blades are ready for winter and not worn, hardened or covered in pine gum, check your battery, top up or change your oil and transmission fluid to a winter product. And lastly change to your winter tires.

In your emergency kit you should have: Flares, flashlight, candles and lighter in a dry sealed bag, battery operated radio, 2 bags of sand placed on either side of the vehicle near the wheel wells, camping shovel, a sleeping bag, water, non-perishable food items, first aid kit, tool kit, jack and jumper cables. Check that flashlight batteries are fresh and charged and keep them in your glovebox. Put a few extras in just in case and carry a portable cell phone charger.
