KANANASKIS IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT  
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA**

Being an improvement district order to grant exclusive right of providing an ambulance service in the Ribbon Creek Emergency Services response area.

WHEREAS Ministerial Order L:102/96 of the Minister of Municipal Affairs delegates all powers, duties and functions of the Minister under the Municipal Government Act to the Minister of Environmental Protection.

WHEREAS Ministerial Order 53/96 delegates certain powers and functions of the Minister of Environmental Protection to the Kananaskis Improvement District Council.

WHEREAS the council upon reviewing Section 7 and Section 49 of the Municipal Government Act has determined that it considers appropriate that an exclusive right be granted for providing an ambulance service in the Ribbon Creek Emergency Response area which is outlined in red on Page 2 of Attachment A.


NOW THEREFORE the Council of Kananaskis Improvement District duly assembled, enacts as follows:


1. That under Section 7 and Section 49 of the Municipal Government Act Council grants exclusive right of providing ambulance service in the Ribbon Creek Emergency Services Response area to 685384 Alberta Ltd. operating as Medic One.
2. That further granting of exclusive right of providing ambulance service can be amended by Council resolution.
3. That a fine of \$500.00 per day <sup>may be</sup> levied for contravention of this order.

Read a first time this 9th day of September, 1997.

Read a second time this 9th day of September, 1997.

Read a third time and finally passed in Council this 9th day of September 1997.

**SCHEDULE A**

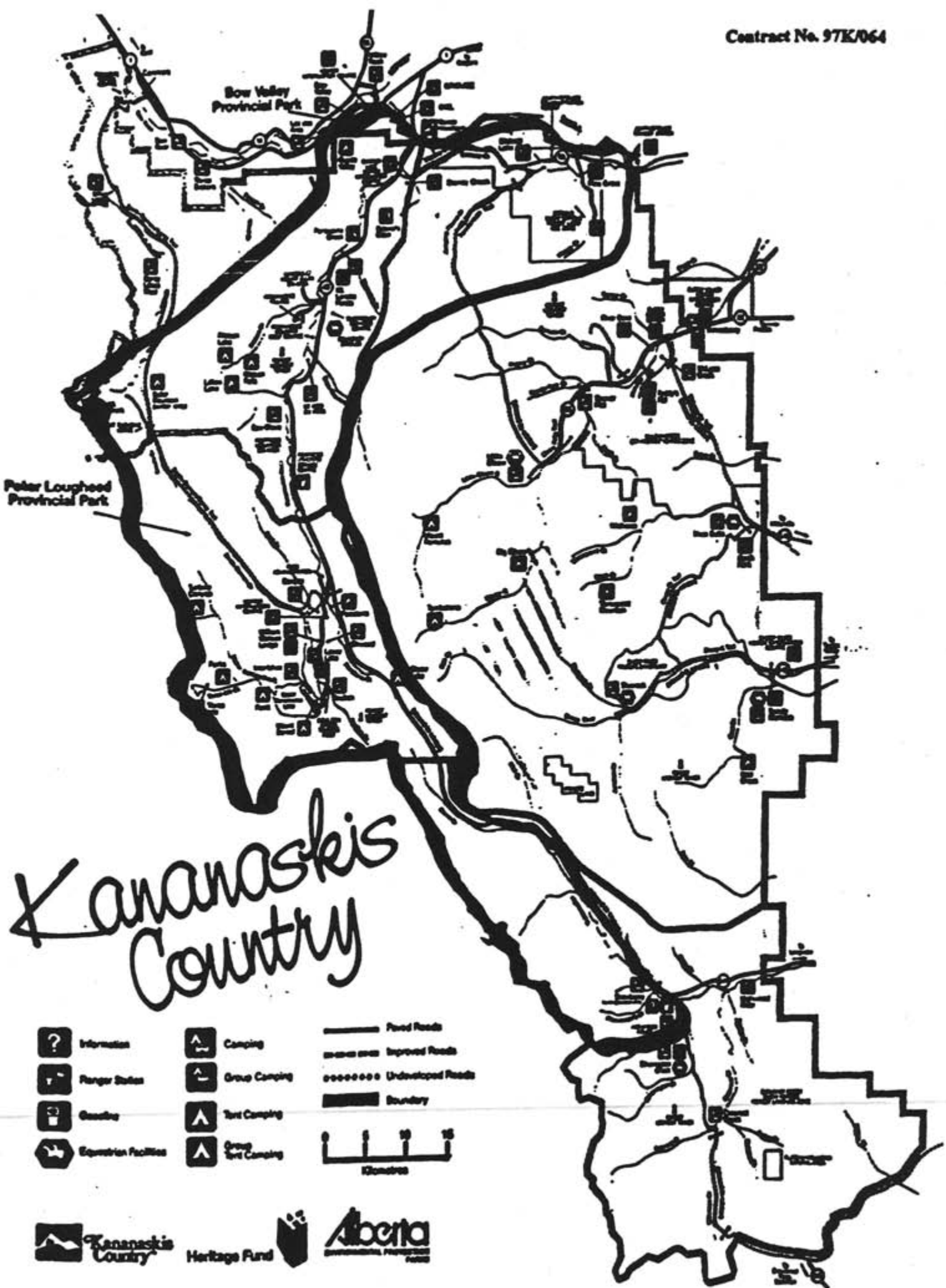
**AREA**

**LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION**

Kananaskis Emergency Services Centre is located on Highway 40, west of Calgary and approximately 25 km south of the Trans-Canada Highway.

An area of coverage fro the Operator is outlined in "red" on the attached map.

Ambulance service is required on a year round basis, covering an area from the Trans-Canada Highway, south along Highway 40 to Highwood Junction, and east along Highway 68 to Sibbald Flats area, and throughout Peter Lougheed Park to the Buller Day Use Area along the Smith Dorrien/Spray Trail, and to Bow Valley Provincial Park, Rafter Six Ranch Resort and YMCA.
