AN ORDER OF THE KANANASKIS IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT TO AUTHORIZE THE COUNCIL OF THE KANANASKIS IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT TO IMPOSE A TAX ON THE EQUIPMENT USED IN THE DRILLING OF ANY WELL FOR WHICH A LICENCE IS REQUIRED UNDER THE OIL AND GAS CONSERVATION ACT

Whereas pursuant to the provisions of Section 388 of the *Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26.1, 1994*, as amended, and the regulations published pursuant to the said Act, The Council of the Kananaskis Improvement District duly assembled hereby orders as follows:

1. This Order may be cited as the Well Drilling Equipment Tax Order.
2. The Chief Administrative Officer is hereby authorized to ^{administer} ~~impose~~ a well drilling equipment tax in respect of equipment used to drill a well for which a licence is required under *The Oil and Gas Conservation Act*, as amended.
3. The tax imposed pursuant to this Order shall be calculated in accordance with the tax rate set out in the Well Drilling Equipment Tax Rate Regulation AR 61/2002, as amended, and shall become due and payable upon cessation of the drilling or servicing operation or **"shall become due and payable upon completion of the drilling, deepening or servicing of any well"**
4. In the event of a tax imposed pursuant to this Order remains unpaid for a period of Thirty (30) days after the cessation of the drilling or servicing operation, the ~~Chief Administrative Officer~~, or any person appointed by ~~him~~ in writing, may issue a distress warrant and seize goods pursuant to Part 10, Division 9 of the *Municipal Government Act*.
