





MINISTERIAL ORDER

I, Hector Goudreau, Minister of Tourism, Parks, Recreation and Culture, pursuant to Section 588 of the *Municipal Government Act*, **HEREBY MAKE THE ORDER** in the attached appendix being the Terms of Reference for the Kananaskis Improvement District Council and appointment of its members. This Order supersedes Ministerial Order #02/05.

F. That notwithstanding the provisions of section 167 of the *Municipal Government Act*, the quorum of the Council shall be three (3) members.

G. In the event that:

1. vacancies on the Council for any reason cause the number of Council members to be less than a quorum; or
2. one or more Councillors is required to abstain on any vote or is permitted to abstain from any vote and chooses to do so, and the remaining Councillors are less than a quorum; or
3. the number of Councillors able to attend a Council meeting is less than a quorum;

then in such case, and for so long as there is no quorum the employee of the Government of Alberta holding the position of Chief Administrative Officer – Kananaskis Improvement District shall be an official administrator with all the powers of the Council pursuant to section 168 of the *Municipal Government Act* with such amendments to section 168 as are necessary to give effect to this provision. Section 168 as amended applies to the Kananaskis Improvement District.

H. This is a specific order as contemplated by the provisions of Schedule B, Ministerial Order 53/96 (executed by the Minister of Environmental Protection) applicable to said section 167.

I. Paragraph 1(b) of Ministerial Order 54/96 is repealed and is hereby replaced with “generally accepted accounting principles, and any accounting and reporting practices set by the Senior Financial Officer of the Ministry of Tourism, Parks, Recreation and Culture as may be applicable to the Kananaskis Improvement District.

J. This order shall take effect on October 16, 2007.
