This course is available to members of recognized emergency services organizations. This course is being delivered over two weekends with a Friday start on the first weekend, the exam and practical evaluations will be on July 20, 2025, at the Kananaskis Emergency Services Centre. The Pumping course covers all of the elements under Chapters 5 - 15 of NFPA 1002. The intent of the program is to establish competence in the operation of an apparatus equipped with a fire pump, building on the skills learned in the Driver/Operator course. Throughout the course you will learn more about the mechanical workings of a fire pump, establishment of sustainable water supply, calculation of flow rates and friction loss to establish adequate fire streams and trouble shooting.

Students will be required to purchase their own textbook: IFSTA Pumping and Aerial Apparatus Driver 3rd Edition. The textbook is available from the Alberta Fire Chief's Association bookstore (link is below).
